Show competition

In the Show competition the bands have to present marching figures while playing music. Each show has to have a length of 10-15 minutes. The competition takes place at the Mikkelberg on a 70x40m big field.

Concert competition

In the concert competition the bands have to present two pieces of music. These are presented in front of a jury. A score needs to be handed in beforehand. The concert competition takes place in the gymnasium by the Jens-Iwersen-Schule.

Marching competition

In the marching competion the bands have to present two pieces of music while marching and one piece of music standing in front of a jury. The marching competition is also at the Mikkelberg.

Marching Parade

In this competition the bands can present their music and marching in an assigned field in 10-13 minutes. The difference to the marching competition is, that the bandncan choose their own steps and figures etc in the marked area.
